

Honey Harbour Association- Special Event & Site Rental Policy

Purpose: From time to time the Board of Directors (BoD) of the Honey Harbour Association (HHA) is asked (normally) by members if they can hold a special event at the Schoolhouse. This policy provides guidelines for the BoD and event applicant.

Conceptually:

1. This benefit should be for members only (or levy a significant premium as a rental fee)
2. The time requested must not conflict with HHA's scheduling of activities.
3. Events must be over by 10:00 PM respecting our neighbours
4. No fireworks or campfires permitted

Alcohol or no alcohol:

Where no alcohol will be served or sold

5. The event host shall obtain the following:
 - (i) "Special Event Liability Insurance" (available from PAL Insurance Brokers Canada Ltd (palcanada.com) naming as co-insureds the Honey Harbour Association Inc (HHA) and the Honey Harbour Community Church Inc (HHCCI) as co-insured.
 - (ii) proof of ""Special Event Liability Insurance" shall be provided to HHA before the date requested can be confirmed

Where alcohol will be served or sold

6. The event host shall obtain the following:
 - (i) "Special Occasion Permit" issued by the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO) (www.AGCO.ca/alcohol/special-occasion-permits-private-events)
 - (ii) "Party alcohol liability insurance" (available from PAL Insurance Brokers Canada Ltd (palcanada.com) or your personal insurance broker) naming as co-insureds the Honey Harbour Association Inc (HHA) and the Honey Harbour Community Church Inc (HHCCInc.) as co-insured.
(above two documents can take up to 2 months to obtain)
 - (iii) Smart Serve - only those individuals holding a current Smart Serve license are permitted to serve alcohol
 - (iv) "Special Event Liability Insurance" (available from PAL Insurance Brokers Canada Ltd (palcanada.com) naming the Honey Harbour Association Inc (HHA) and the Honey Harbour Community Church Inc (HHCCI) as co-insureds.
 - (v) proof of ""Special Event Liability Insurance" shall be provided to HHA before the date requested can be confirmed
 - (vi) Proof of all above documents shall be provided to HHA before the date requested can be confirmed
7. The Special Event rental fee shall be paid by e-transfer to "admin@honeyharbourassociation.org"
Note: rental fee may be waived for:
 - past and present HHA board members
 - those whose names are listed on the Schoolhouse building plaque or on a dock slip plate
8. A key holder/property oversight/PA system tech shall be required (normally for a fee)
9. A damage deposit shall be paid by e-transfer 30 days in advance of the event
damage deposit may be refunded providing no damage is done
10. A rental fee may be assessed or a specified donation made to HHA

NOTE: Proof of above documents must be submitted to HHA before requested event date can be confirmed.

Where alcohol is sold or served the Applicant shall secure the following:

1. “Special Occasion Permit” from Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO)
2. “Party alcohol liability” insurance naming the Honey Harbour Association Inc (HHA) and the Honey Harbour Community Church Inc (HHCCInc.) as co-insureds
3. Smart Serve licensed personnel who serve the alcohol
4. “Special Event Liability Insurance” (available from PAL Insurance Brokers Canada Ltd) (palcanada.com) naming the Honey Harbour Association Inc (HHA) and the Honey Harbour Community Church Inc (HHCCI) as co-insureds.

NOTE: Proof of above documents must be submitted to HHA before requested event date can be confirmed.

Please take note of the following information about the Schoolhouse property:

Water onsite is filtered and UV light sterilized but HHA does not warrant the water is drinkable!
